From routine maintenance and servicing to complete component overhauls, your learner will be guided over two years for an Apprenticeship or three years for an Advanced Apprenticeship, by their own occupationally trained and qualified Vocational Learning Advisor (VLA).

- Functional Skills Level 1 in Maths and English and ICT (Essential Skills for Wales and Core Skills for Scotland)

On completion of the three year Advanced Apprenticeship your Service Technician will receive the following:

- Level 3 Diploma in Light Vehicle Maintenance and Repair Competence (VCQ) (SVQ 7 in Scotland)
- Level 3 Diploma in Light Vehicle Maintenance and Repair Principles (VRQ) (Level 7 in Scotland)
- Functional Skills Level 2 in Maths and English and ICT (Essential Skills for Wales and Core Skills for Scotland)
- Complete 5 Technical training courses

 - MTC_154 - Mazda Modular Diagnostic System
 - MTC_156 - Electrics / Electronics
 - MTC_158 - Servicing and PDI
